

Calendar for Lansing Village Elections

April 24, 2007

- Feb. 6 First day to sign independent nominating petitions.
- Mar. 13-20 Dates for filing independent nominating petitions.
- Mar. 23 Dates for filing statements of receipts and expenses.
Apr 13 for village election - where required - pursuant
May 21 to Rules and Regulations of New York State BOE.
- Mar. 23 Last day to file certificate of acceptance or
declination of an independent nomination for an
office to be filled at the General Village Election.
- Mar. 26 Last day to file certificate filling vacancy in an
independent nomination.
- Apr. 13 Last day for voter to register with Board of Elections
to vote in village election.
- Apr. 17 Last day for Board of Elections to receive
application for an absentee ballot to be mailed to a
voter.
- Apr. 20 Last day to open voting machines for inspection by
candidates or representatives.
- Apr. 23 Last day for applicant (or his agent) to personally
deliver application for an absentee ballot to the
Board of Elections.
- Apr. 24 **Election Day. Polls open Noon to 9 p.m.**
- May 1 Last day for Board of Elections to complete canvass
of village elections conducted by the Board of
Elections.

OFFICES TO BE FILLED:

Mayor – 2 yr. term
Trustees (2) - 2 yr. term

Polling Place: Oakcrest Fire Station, 119 Oakcrest Road.

Registration by Mail—Forms for Registration by mail may be obtained at the following offices: Board of Elections, Town Clerk, Village Clerk, Chamber of Commerce, Dept. of Motor Vehicles and other State Agencies providing services to the public.

Absentee Voting—Civilians may qualify to vote by absentee ballot if their duties, occupation, or business requires them to be away from their county of residence, or if on vacation the day of any Village Election (Including spouse, parent or child accompanying such person).

An application for absentee ballot to be mailed to the voter must be received by the Board of Elections not later than seven days before the Election. If the applicant or his agent delivers the application to the Board of Elections in person, such application must be received not later than the day before the election. Absentee ballot envelopes must be postmarked not later than the day before the election.
